Notice Regarding Support in Response to the Tohoku Pacific Offshore Earthquake

Tokyo, Japan March 22, 2011 — Otsuka Holdings Co., Ltd. prays for the many lives lost as a result of the Tohoku Pacific offshore earthquake and expresses its deepest condolences to all those and their families who have suffered injury or damage.
